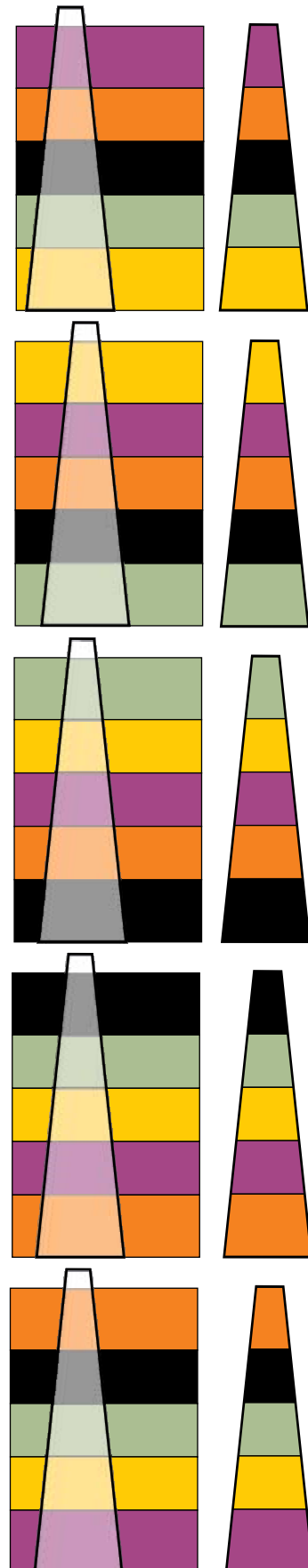


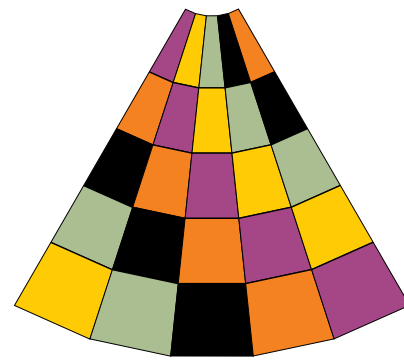


Fabric	Yardage	Cut Strips
A	¼ yd (6" actual)	three strips 2" x width
B	¼ yd (6" actual)	three strips 2" x width
C	¼ yd (6" actual)	three strips 2" x width
D	¼ yd (6" actual)	three strips 2" x width
E	¼ yd (6" actual)	three strips 2" x width
Center	5" X 5" piece	
Backing	21" x 21" square	
Batting	20" x 20" square	
Binding	¾ yd	



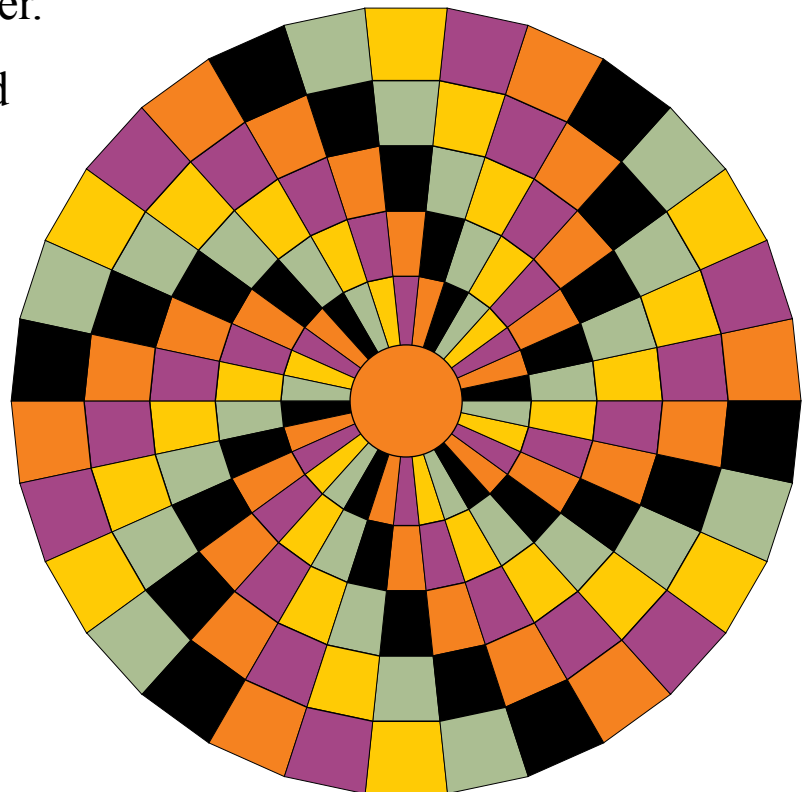
- ☺ Cut three 2" wide strips of each fabric.
- ☺ Cut the fabric strips in half.
- ☺ Sew strip sets as shown. The strip sets will be about 20" wide.
- ☺ Label each strip set, indicating which is the top of the strip set.
- ☺ Place the 12 degree wedge on the strip set so the widest portion is aligned with the bottom of the last strip. The tip of the wedge will probably extend beyond your strip set. This is okay!
- ☺ Cut out six fabric wedges from each strip.

- ☺ Sew five wedges together to make a section as shown.
- ☺ Sew six sections together to make a circle.
- ☺ Press the seams from the back.
- ☺ Applique a circle in the center.
- ☺ Add backing and batting and quilt as desired.
